RULES

- Two scholarships/bursaries are being offered – each for **65% of the applicable student fee (full fee is €4,225.00 this year but applicable fee is net of any discounts – families, etc.) for each of a recipient's 5 or 6 years** at the College. **Note that the fee for each year** is not usually set until the July prior to the August in which the scholarship/bursary recipient enters the College.
- A review will be held at the end of each year to ascertain if academic and behavioural standards are being maintained. Satisfactory standards will be necessary for continuation of a scholarship/bursary.
- ***There will be a written examination (half an hour each) in English, Irish (unless exempt) and Maths.*** The College Authorities have set the examination on the basis of these three papers, English, Irish and Maths. Individual Applicants may qualify for exemption from some of these subjects in their second level schooling. However each subject is a part of the general school curriculum and accordingly forms the basis of the scholarship examination.
- Applicants must be applying for a place in **First Year** commencing **August 2018**.
- Applicants must be in **6th Class** in Primary School **at the time they sit the scholarship**.
- Successful applicants must comply with the general requirements for admission to the College, and they will be required to attend an interview with the College Principal.
- The decision of the College authorities in relation to the allocation of scholarships/bursaries shall be binding.
- Applicants for scholarships this year must be born on or after 01 January '05 and before 01 January '07.
- It is the responsibility of **parents, not teachers**, to complete and return the form.

All applicants will be provided with specific details of the arrangements for the Scholarship Day approximately two weeks prior to 2nd December 2017.
